1. Objectives

The purpose of this normative document is to present the requirements for the implementation of the certification of company Chains of Custody.

Companies requires a reliable and credible mechanism to give their customers credible guarantees on the origin of the raw materials in wood or wood-based they use in their productions. This is the aim of the chain of custody that completes the certification of the PEFC sustainable forest management.

2. Scope of application

The standard PEFC ST 2002:2010, “Chain of Custody of Forest-Based Products – Requirements”, adopted by the General Assembly of the PEFC Council on 12 November 2010 together with its annexes were adopted without modification by the PEFC Belgium at its Extraordinary General Assembly on 27 June 2012 and form an integral part of the Belgian Forest Certification Scheme.
