BUYING LEGAL & SUSTAINABLE TIMBER

All timber and timber products supplied to our sites must have a full **Chain of Custody** or demonstrated as legal and sustainable in line with the UK Government's Timber Procurement Policy (Category A or B).

Evidence of legal and sustainable timber can be demonstrated by supplying timber or timber products with Chain of Custody under PEFC or FSC®



CLAIMS

These are the only acceptable claims which can be made for PEFC Certified timber.

For the majority of construction standards, specifications and labels, 70% is the minimum accepted claim.



TIMBER DELIVERY CHECKLIST

INFORMATION REQUIRED ON TIMBER DELIVERY DOCUMENTS FOR CHAIN OF CUSTODY

- 1 Supplier's name and address
- 2 Site delivery address
- 3 Clear product description
- 4 Delivery quantity for each certified product
- 5 Delivery date
- 6 Formal claim against each certified product
(see overleaf)
- 7 Supplier's Chain of Custody certificate number
e.g. BMT-PEFC-1234

In addition, some contractors may wish to procure Category B material, which may be claimed as PEFC Controlled Sources or Grown in Britain under the GiB licensing scheme.
